TRADE STAND REGULATIONS

- 1 Trade Stand Entries will only be accepted if made prior to 1st March 2018 on a properly completed Trade Stand Space Application form accompanied by the total fee.
- 2 Trade Stand Space will be available as follows:- OPEN SPACE £45.00 per 3 metres frontage. £70.00 per 6 metres frontage. Depth of stands will be 6m. Please advise if greater depth is required.
- 3 All Trade Stands must be open and manned from 9.00 am on Easter Monday 2nd April 2018
- 4 Each stand holder will be issued with one vehicle label. Further vehicle labels will be available if needed on request. Vehicles must not be parked in the avenues, or on stand frontages during the hours the event is open to the public.
- 5 There should be no vehicle movement between the hours of 9.00 am & 2.30 pm on 2nd April 2018
- 6 Exhibitors are only permitted to trade in goods and/or services as described on their accepted entry form.
- 7 Exhibitors shall not offer for sale for immediate consumption, any food, sweets, foodstuffs, drinks, cigarettes or tobacco without the express permission of the Society. Small samples may be given away, free of charge, for sales promotion purposes.
- 8 Exhibitors may make their own arrangements for catering on their stands, provided that no exhibitor may sell or offer for sale any foodstuffs or beverages on his stand unless written permission has been obtained from the Society.
- 9 Exhibitors catering or selling foodstuffs on their stands are reminded that they must conform with the requirements of the Food Hygiene Regulations 1970. Officers of the Environmental Health Department of the Local Authority have right of access to all stands during the Parade.
- 10 Exhibitors are reminded that the Medicines Act 1968 and the Poisons Act 1972 apply to the display and sale of veterinary products, medicines, etc. All displays and sales must comply with the provision of these Acts, any other relevant Acts and the Rules and Regulations of the Pharmaceutical Society of Great Britain.
- 11 Exhibitors must contain their sales activities to the area allocated and must not block any walkway or avenue or distribute leaflets anywhere other than on their stand.
- 12 Exhibitors may not use any loudspeaker apparatus, engines, or other equipment, participate in any activity or practice, or sell, display or offer for sale any toxic, noxious or offensive substance, article or thing, so as to cause nuisance, annoyance or distress to other exhibitors or to the public.
- 13 All stands will be clearly numbered. Stand numbers must not be removed, defaced or damaged in any way.
- 14 Exhibitors may not commence work on their stand area before Monday 2nd April 2018
- 15 All postholes are to be back filled and the ground/turf reinstated by the exhibitor at the end of the event.
- 16 All stands must be kept clear of rubbish during the time the Show is open to the public.
- 17 All exhibits, mobile units etc must be cleared from the Event site by the evening of Monday 2nd April 2018
- 18 Exhibitors are required to observe all statutory requirements regarding Safety related to their exhibits.
- 19 Exhibitors are allowed to use their own generators providing they cause no distress or nuisance to other exhibitors or to the public.
- 20 Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the Society, its servants or agents, the Society will not be responsible for death, injury, disease, damage or loss caused to any exhibitor or to his or her servants or agents or to any exhibit, animal, vehicle, equipment, plant, machinery, article or thing of whatever nature brought onto Event site by the exhibitor.
- 21 Save as aforesaid, the exhibitor shall indemnify the Society against all claims, losses, damages and expenses whatsoever in any way arising out of the presence of or the taking part of the exhibitor, his or her servants, agents, exhibits, animals, plant, vehicle, equipment, machinery, articles or other things of whatever nature on the Event site and shall assume full responsibility thereof.
Acceptance of this rule shall be a condition of entry or participation in any event, competition or display, promoted or arranged by the Society.
The Society accepts no responsibility or liability whatsoever for any statement or information in any document published by the Society.
The Society will in no case accept liability or any loss or damage (whether direct or indirect) arising from or causes by the abandonment or cancellation, whether total or partial, or the postponement of the London Harness Horse Parade for whatever reason.
- 22 (a) It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to insure all property and livestock on the Event site or elsewhere which is his own, or for which he is responsible.
(b) The Society requires exhibitors to effect Employers Liability insurance where this is required by statute.
(c) The Society also requires exhibitors to effect Public Liability and Products Liability insurance with a minimum indemnity of £5,000,000 to protect their liability under paragraph 20 and 21 above. Evidence to such insurance to be submitted with application form.
